Astronomy for May 2016

- May 1st Jupiter sits High in the South at 10 PM; Mars Rises at 10:29; Saturn Rises at 10:59 with its Rings well-angled for Observation; Venus is Lost in the Sun's Glare in May
- May 2nd Neptune Appears only Half a Degree Below the Waning Crescent Moon; You will need Binoculars to see the Faintly Blue Disc of Neptune at Magnitude 7.92
- May 5th Night and May 6th Morning Eta Aquarid Meteor Shower Peaks (Debris Trail from Halley's Comet), Producing up to 30 Meteors/Hr, Traveling 148,000 MPH; (Eta Aquarid meteors are often seen as "Earthgrazers," - long meteors that appear to skim the surface of the earth at the horizon)
- May 9th Transit of Mercury Across the Sun at McCormick Observatory, 9 AM -2:42 PM: CAS Solar Filter-Equipped Member Telescopes Available for Observations
- May 14th Jupiter and the Waxing Gibbous Moon are within 4 Degrees
- May 21st and 22nd Full Moon, Mars, and Saturn Travel Together Across the Night Sky
